I came across a new product to cure the problem and thought I would pass it on for any of you who are considering any of the Jabiru series for your aircraft. Rotec Engineering, the ones that build the radials, have come up with a liquid cooled cylinder head which improves combustion (more HP) and eliminates all of the problems associated with the air cooled Jabiru heads.
