He has written and produced forty-eight local history videos. In 2009, Mark hosted a live interview roundtable program on C4 television in the Vegas valley and is regularly seen on the History Channel's "Pawn Stars" as a visiting expert

In addition to the Nevada Museums Association, where he served as President from 2000 to 2002 and 2008-2010, Mark served on the California Association of Museums and Western Museums Association boards. He is married to Dr. Colleen Hall-Patton, a professor of Sociology and Women's Studies at UNLV, and they are the parents of Joseph and Ellen Hall-Patton.
