Old Business:

Tonight we will continue to discuss:

- 1. We have more information this month on the Prop Balancer. Seb contacted two individuals that do Prop balancing and one normally charges \$175 and the other \$150. The \$175 individual is willing to discount if we can get a number of individuals together all at once. There are several methods of acquiring the equipment for the chapter.
 - a. Outright purchase by chapter
 - b. 10 Interested individuals contribute \$150 each (total cost is approx.
 \$1500) and donate it to the chapter with anyone other than a member pays a fee to use it.
 - c. Or a combination of the fewer individuals and Chapter makes up the difference.

<u>Discussion of options</u>. Settled on initial buy-in by members with balance by club.

Informal vote on number who would buy in at \$150 (9), \$100 (9) \$50 (13).
