HAYWARD, CA, March 26, 2014 -- The Hayward Air Rally, the longest continually-held proficiency flying event in North America, has selected seven teenagers to receive fully-paid scholarships including tuition and roundtrip airfare to the Experimental Aircraft Association's (EAA) Advanced Air Academy summer 2014 program.

In partnership with local chapters of the EAA, the Hayward Air Rally is pleased to announce the winners of the scholarships as
